1996 CBA NATIONAL TOURNAMENT

CBA's 20th National Tournament was nearly the tournament that wasn't, thanks to an uninvited hussy named Hurricane Fran. After tearing up the Carolinas, she headed north, somewhat tired, but by no means exhausted, to see what damage she could do to the northern Virginia countryside before time and energy ran out on her. After dumping around ten inches of rain—reports varied—stripping limbs from numerous trees, and downing power lines throughout the area, she headed north, finally out of our hair.

On Friday, the day before the National Tournament, the situation at the Fairfax Rod and Gun Club looked very discouraging; no power, roads flooded, torrential downpours, and high winds. Many competitors were doubtful that the shoot could be held, but most of them showed up anyway. And it was a good thing they did, too, because Saturday dawned sunny, dry, and calm. We probably couldn't have ordered better shooting conditions, although some may have objected to the heat and humidity.

While some of us experienced difficulty with the fickle breezes that sprang up later, the skillful shooters came through as always. By the end of the Tournament on Sunday afternoon, eleven new National Records had been established!

Of the thirty-eight competitors firing, twenty-two consisted of Heavy Class, four Unrestricted, two Plain Base Bullet, and ten Production. Not since 1988 has Production Class been so well represented at the National Tournament. There were no Long Range Handgun entries this year.

A classic confrontation Tournament watchers have learned to anticipate occurred again this year. It was the Heavy Class shoot-out between Tom Gray and Jay Stanton. As usual, the results this year were a mixed bag, with Tom edging out Jay in the score match by one point. A couple of whiskers in group size was all that separated the two in the 5-shot group match, giving Tom the advantage. However, Jay came storming back when the 10-shot group match commenced, plainly winning that event.

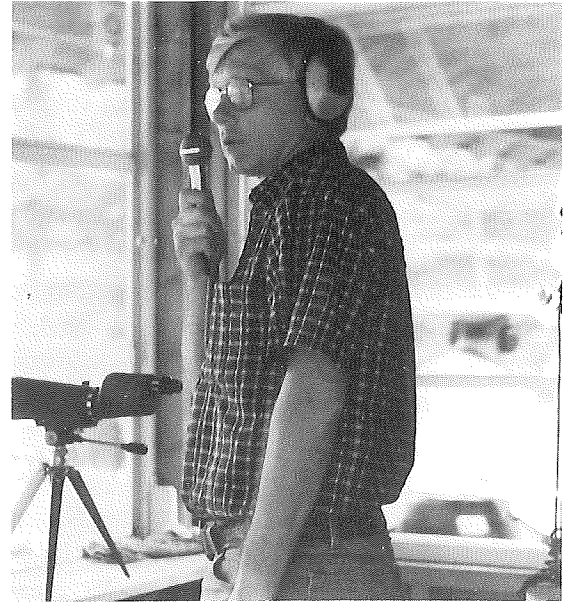
Production Class was clearly dominated by Ed Doonan. He swept all events in that class in a most convincing fashion, also managing to set one new National Record and tie another along the way. Ed's sterling performance garnered him enough winning points to earn him the National Championship Trophy. For the fourth consecutive year, that award has gone to a shooter from the mid-west. There must be something in their drinking water, because, after seeing a couple of them in action, we know it isn't clean living.

Dan Hudson, firing another of his "Guns From Hell", pretty much cleaned up in Unrestricted Class. Unfortunately, that class was contested by only four shooters, in contrast to recent years when it has been better represented.

In the Plain Base Bullet Class, Bev Pinney from British Columbia, was the undisputed winner. He thoroughly impressed folks with the accuracy of plain base bullets and single shot rifles, setting seven of the new records with his Miller-deHaas single shot. Gene Woodruff did some mighty fine shooting that normally would have produced some winning scores, but he wasn't quite able to top Bev's performance. We may have a clue regarding why Bev shoots so consistently well. It seems that his breakfasts consist of an amalgamation of various secret ingredients he concocts every morning and which he terms "porridge" (but who knows what's really in it?), that may have a direct bearing on his Man of Steel exhibition. Further investigation as to its contents—and legality—appears warranted. Whether this item is standard fare for most Canadians is unknown at this time.

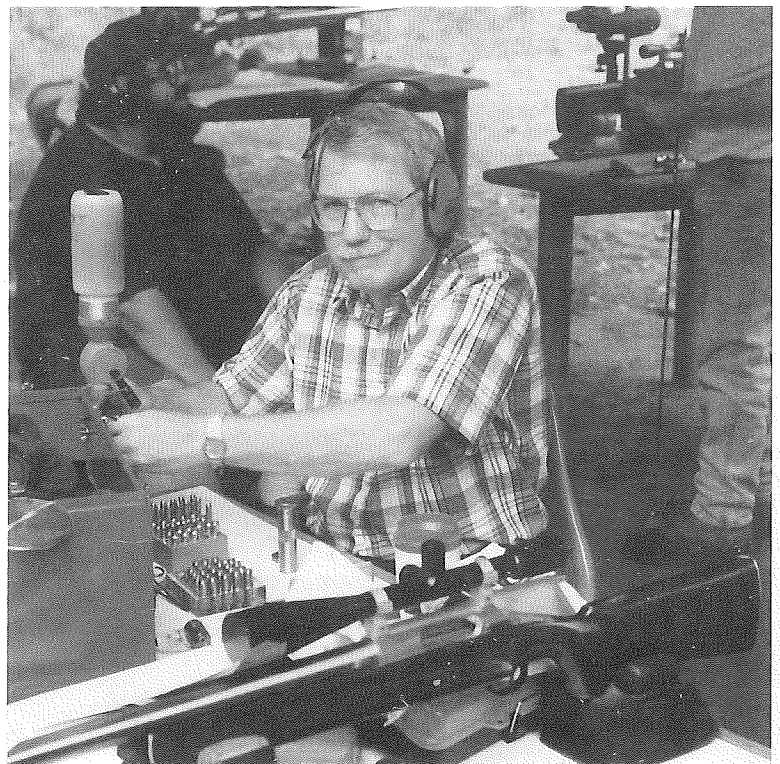
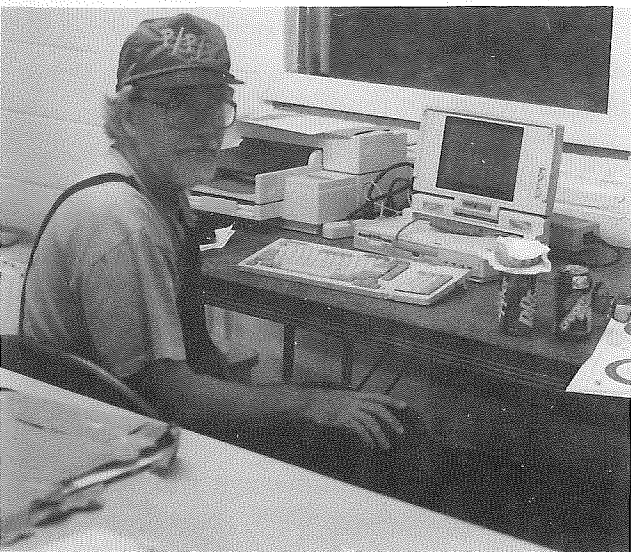

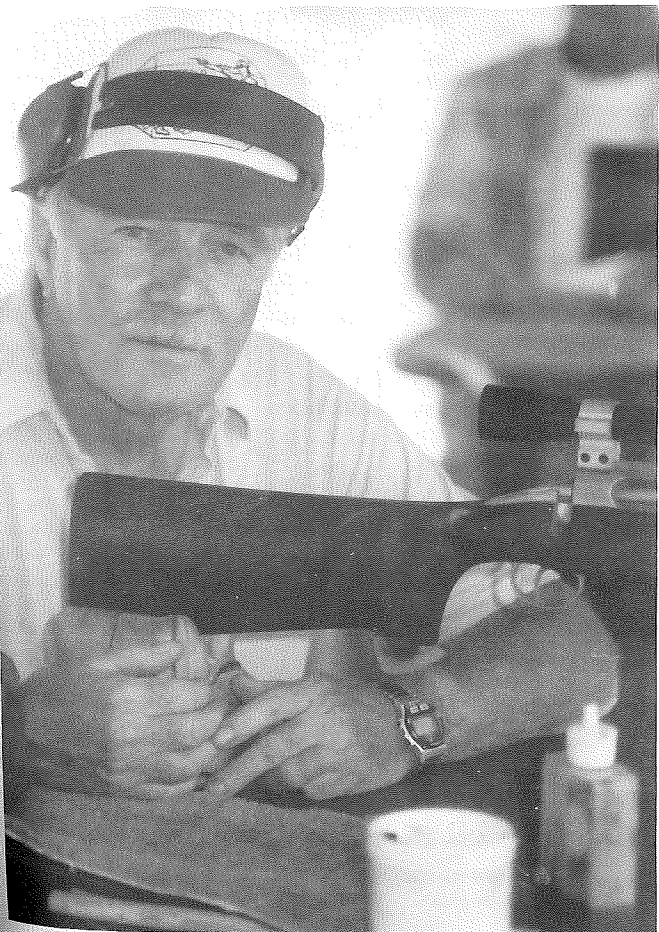
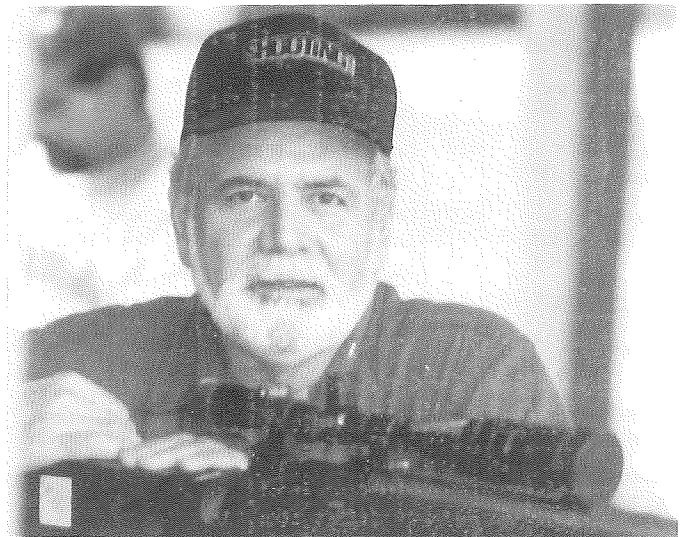
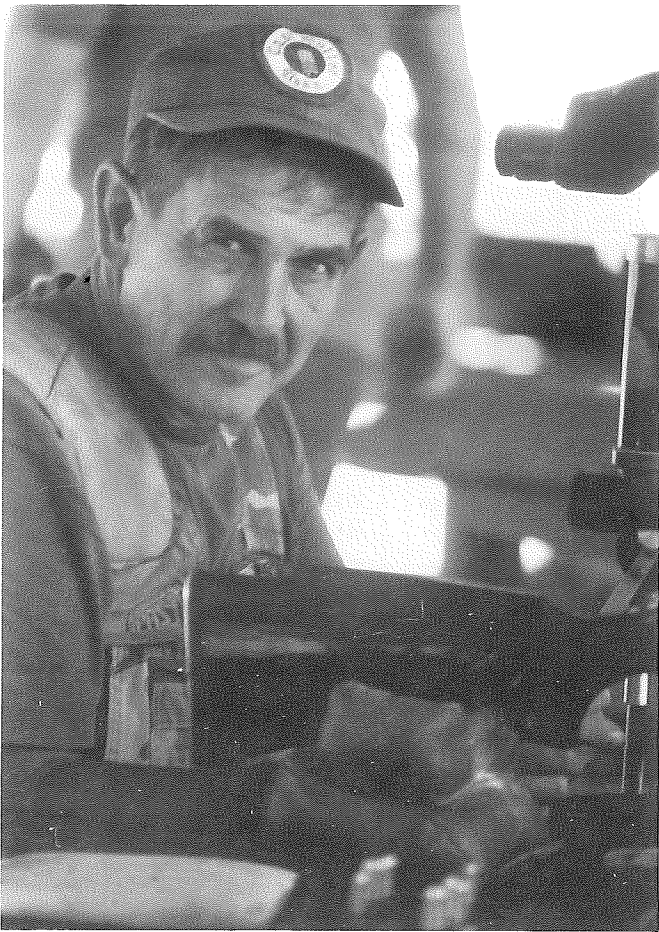
The 1997 National Tournament will be held at the Emerald Empire Gun Club near Springfield, Oregon. See you there! ©
